As per clause 14 (t) of the Energy Conservation Act, 2001, Government of India had provided that Central Government shall take all measures necessary to create awareness and disseminate information for efficient use of energy and its conservation. With the objective to reduce energy intensity, in the area of space cooling, Government of India has recently initiated a campaign to save energy by recommending optimum temperature setting within a building to between 24-25 degree Celsius subject to other factors like humidity, air flow etc. In this context, Director, Energy Management Centre (EMC), as per letter cited, has requested Government to issue a directive to all Government Departments to maintain the internal temperature in their own buildings and buildings coming under their span of control, to between 24-25 degree Celsius with appropriate humidity and airflow to conserve energy subject to operational and functional requirements.


In view of the above, I am to request you to issue necessary directions to all Government Departments and Public Sector Undertakings
