Kerala Water Authority have procured various size of pipes for the Rural Water Supply Scheme to Pathanapuram in Kollam District. When the scheme was re-designed due to non availability of land, the scheme capacity had been reduced and this resulted in proportionate reduction of size of distribution pipes. Hence the already procured pipes which are of higher diameter could not be used. Also as per pipe policy, which came into force on 19.10.2013, AC pipes cannot be used for water supply schemes. The unused AC pipes are now safely stacked by Kerala Water Authority at Pathanapuram. The details of unutilized AC pipes are as follows.

- 450mm AC Class 10 - 4385m
- 450mm AC Class 15 - 3310m
- 400mm AC Class 15 - 87m

Kerala Water Authority can now spare these unutilized AC pipes for works under LSGD, PWD and Irrigation Department for using the same for drainage purpose etc, if required.

In the above circumstances, you are requested to report whether the AC pipes as listed above is required for the works under your jurisdiction, without further delay.
