(iii) 5 (five) years experience in Public Health Engineering or Environmental Engineering or Municipal Services in a government department or semi- government organization or public body including investigation, design, construction, operation and maintenance of water supply or drainage or solid waste management systems and sewerage installations.

Note 3. Period of deputation (istc) including period of deputation (istc) to another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or other Organisations or departments of the central Government shall not to exceed four years.

(ii) The maximum age limit for appointment by deputation (istc) shall not be exceeding 56 years as on the closing date of receipt of applications.

(iii) Candidates from Public Sector Undertakings should indicate whether the pay scale held by them is on the Central DA pattern or the Industrial DA pattern.

(iv) Consultation with Union public service commission is necessary on each occasion.

Note 4. For the purpose of computing minimum qualifying service for appointment on deputation basis, the service rendered on a regular basis by an officer prior to 1st January, 2006 or the date from which the revised pay structure based on the Sixth Central Pay Commission recommendation has been extended,

shall be deemed to be service rendered in the corresponding grade pay or pay scale extended based on the recommendation of the Commission except where there has been merger of more than one pre-revised scale of pay into one grade with a common grade pay or pay scale, and where this benefit will extend only for the post for which that grade pay or pay scale is the normal replacement grade without any upgradation.


