Introduction

The Translational Research and Professional Leadership Centre (TPLC) which was established in GEC Bartonhill have been conducting programmes to transform the professionals to transform the nation. This work aims at giving an overview on social responsibility of professionals and to introduce them to identify the socially relevant projects. The project planning and execution in a time bound manner also will be discussed. It is planned to create a Project Bank which can cater to students undertaking socially relevant projects as part of their academic programs. The programme is arranged in association with ISTE Kerala Section.

Methodology
